FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

As we remember our mothers on Mother's Day, I thought it would be appropriate to reflect on the motherhood of the Blessed Virgin Mary by recalling the words of Saint Pope John Paul II in his beautiful encyclical of 1987 entitled "Mother of the Redeemer" (*Redemptoris Mater*).

Mary's motherhood, completely pervaded by her spousal attitude as the "handmaid of the Lord," constitutes the first and fundamental dimension of that mediation which the Church confesses and proclaims in her regard and continually "commends to the hearts of the faithful," since the Church has great trust in her. For it must be recognized that before anyone else it was God himself, the Eternal Father, who entrusted himself to the Virgin of Nazareth, giving her his own Son in the mystery of the Incarnation. Her election to the supreme office and dignity of Mother of the Son of God refers, on the ontological level, to the very reality of the union of the two natures in the person of the Word (hypostatic union). This basic fact of being the Mother of the Son of God is from the very beginning a complete openness to the person of Christ, to his whole work, to his whole mission. The words "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord" testify to Mary's openness of spirit: she perfectly unites in herself the love proper to virginity and the love characteristic of motherhood, which are joined and, as it were, fused together.

For this reason, Mary became not only the "nursing mother" of the Son of Man but also the "associate of unique nobility" of the Messiah and Redeemer. As I have already said, she advanced in her pilgrimage of faith, and in this pilgrimage to the foot of the Cross there was simultaneously accomplished her maternal cooperation with the Savior's whole mission through her actions and sufferings. Along the path of this collaboration with the work of her Son, the Redeemer, Mary's motherhood itself underwent a singular transformation, becoming ever more imbued with "burning charity" towards all those to whom Christ's mission was directed. Through this "burning charity," which sought to achieve, in union with Christ, the restoration of "supernatural life to souls," Mary entered, in a way all her own, into the one mediation "between God and men" which is the mediation of the man Christ Jesus. If she was the first to experience within herself the supernatural consequences of this one mediation-in the Annunciation she had been greeted as "full of grace"-then we must say that through this fullness of

grace and supernatural life she was especially predisposed to cooperation with Christ, the one Mediator of human salvation. And such cooperation is precisely this mediation subordinated to the mediation of Christ. (RM, 39)

On Mothers' Day, we give thanks to God especially for Mary, the Mother of Jesus and the Mother of us all and we give thanks for all of our mothers: those still living and those who have passed on to their eternal reward. We would not be here without them! Under St. Mary's mantle, may all mothers find protection, guidance and consolation. Our Blessed Mother, pray for us!



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Al recordar a nuestras madres en el Día de la Madre, pensé que sería oportuno reflexionar sobre la maternidad de la Santísima Virgen María recordando las palabras del Santo Papa Juan Pablo II en su hermosa encíclica de 1987 titulada "Madre del Redentor" (Redemptoris Mater).

La maternidad de María, impregnada profundamente por la actitud esponsal de "esclava del Señor", constituye la dimensión primera y fundamental de aquella mediación que la Iglesia confiesa y proclama respecto a ella,¹⁰⁰ y continuamente "recomienda a la piedad de los fieles" porque confía mucho en esta mediación. En efecto, conviene reconocer que, antes que nadie, Dios mismo, el eterno Padre, se entregó a la Virgen de Nazaret, dándole su propio Hijo en el misterio de la Encarnación. Esta elección suya al sumo cometido y dignidad de Madre del Hijo de Dios, a nivel ontológico, se refiere a la realidad misma de la unión de las dos naturalezas en la persona del Verbo (unión hipostática). Este hecho fundamental de ser la Madre del Hijo de Dios supone, desde el principio, una apertura total a la persona de Cristo, a toda su obra y misión. Las palabras "he aquí la esclava del Señor" atestiguan esta apertura del espíritu de María, la cual, de manera perfecta, reúne en sí misma el amor propio de la virginidad y el amor característico de la maternidad, unidos y como fundidos juntamente.

Por tanto María ha llegado a ser no sólo la "madre-nodriza" del Hijo del hombre, sino también la "compañera singularmente generosa"¹⁰¹ del Mesías y Redentor. Ella —como ya he dicho— avanzaba en la peregrinación de la fe y en esta peregrinación suya hasta los pies de la Cruz se ha realizado, al mismo tiempo, su cooperación materna en toda la misión del Salvador mediante sus acciones y sufrimientos. A través de esta colaboración en la obra del Hijo Redentor, la maternidad misma de María conocía una transformación singular, colmándose cada vez más de "ardiente caridad" hacia todos aquellos a quienes estaba dirigida la misión de Cristo. Por medio de esta "ardiente caridad", orientada a realizar en unión con Cristo la restauración de la "vida sobrenatural de las almas", María entraba de manera muy personal en la única mediación "entre Dios y los hombres", que es la mediación del hombre Cristo Jesús. Si ella fue la

la primera en experimentar en sí misma los efectos sobrenaturales de esta única mediación —ya en la anunciaciόn había sido saludada como "llena de gracia"— entonces es necesario decir, que por esta plenitud de gracia y de vida sobrenatural, estaba particularmente predispuesta a la cooperación con Cristo, único mediador de la salvación humana. Y tal cooperación es precisamente esta mediación subordinada a la mediación de Cristo. (RM 39)

En el Día de la Madres, damos gracias a Dios especialmente por María, Madre de Jesús y Madre de todos nosotros y damos gracias por todas nuestras madres: las que aún viven y las que han pasado a su recompensa eterna. ¡No estuvieron aquí sin ellas! Que bajo el manto de Santa María todas las madres encuentren protección, guía y consuelo. ¡Santísima Madre, ruega por nosotros!




