FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

In recent weeks, we made our way through the heart of the "sacrament season", when many of our catechism students made their First Confession and received the Eucharist for the first time. A number of other students celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation on Thursday, June 9th. Moreover, we continue to celebrate a healthy number of Baptisms and weddings. Another thing that I have noticed is that Fr. Joseph and I have had a steady stream of funeral Masses over the last couple of months. In the past, it seemed that funerals came in spurts. You might have three or four funerals over a two-week period, but then we would go a month celebrating only a couple of funerals. Lately, it seems we have been celebrating two or three funerals a week. In any case, the Baptisms, Confessions, Holy Communion, Confirmations, Weddings and Funerals all point to the fact that St. Mary's Parish is alive with God's grace!

As always, when it comes to the life of grace, the role of the parents is of utmost importance. If the parents are engaged in their Catholic faith, attending Mass on Sundays, learning about the faith themselves, praying with their children and talking about the faith with their children, the children thrive not only spiritually, but also in all the other ways: socially, psychologically, emotionally and physically. As we mark Father's Day this weekend, I would like to point out the importance of the father in the children's practice of the faith. Studies have shown that in families where the father practices his Catholic faith, even if the mother does not, the children will practice the Catholic faith at relatively high levels. On the other hand, if the mother practices the faith, but the father does not, the level of the children's religious practice is considerably lower, especially among boys. To be sure, this does not mean that the mother does not play an important role in the children's practice of the faith. No, her role is essential. It merely emphasizes the importance of the father's religious practice in the spiritual and religious development of the children. (cf. "The Importance of Fathers" by Bishop Donald J. Hying in the "Diocese of Madison Catholic Herald" June 16, 2021)

Reflecting on Saint Joseph in his 2020 *Apostolic Letter* entitled "With a Father's Heart," Pope Francis wrote: "Fathers are not born, but made. A man does not become a father simply by bringing a child into the world, but by taking up the responsibility to care for that child. Whenever a man accepts responsibility for the life of another, in some way he becomes a father to that person." (*Patris Corde*, 7) We give thanks to God for all fathers and we pray that they faithfully and tirelessly live their God-given task as spiritual leaders of their families. St. Joseph, pray for us. May you have a blessed week!

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

En las últimas semanas, abrimos paso en el corazón de la “temporada sacramental”, cuando muchos de nuestros estudiantes de catecismo hicieron su Primera Confesión y recibieron la Eucaristía por primera vez. Varios otros estudiantes celebraron el Sacramento de la Confirmación el jueves 9 de junio. Además, seguimos celebrando un buen número de bautizos y bodas. Otra cosa que he notado es que el Padre Joseph y yo hemos tenido un flujo constante de Misas de funerales durante los últimos meses. En el pasado, parecía que los funerales llegaban en olas. Era posible tener tres o cuatro funerales durante un período de dos semanas, pero luego pasábamos un mes celebrando solo un par de funerales. Últimamente, parece que hemos estado celebrando dos o tres funerales a la semana. En cualquier caso, los Bautismos, las Confesiones, las Sagradas Comuniones, las Confirmaciones, las Bodas y los Funerales apuntan al hecho de que la Parroquia de Santa María está viva con la gracia de Dios.

Como siempre, cuando se trata de la vida de gracia, el papel de los padres es de suma importancia. Si los padres están comprometidos con su fe católica, asisten a Misa los domingos, aprenden sobre la fe ellos mismos, oran con sus hijos y hablan sobre la fe con sus hijos, los niños prosperan no solo espiritualmente, sino también en todas las demás áreas: socialmente, psicológica, emocional y físicamente. Al conmemorar el Día del Padre este fin de semana, me gustaría señalar la importancia del padre en la práctica de la fe de los niños. Los estudios han demostrado que en las familias donde el padre practica su fe católica, incluso si la madre no lo hace, los niños practican la fe católica en niveles relativamente altos. En cambio, si la madre practica la fe, pero el padre no, el nivel de práctica religiosa de los hijos es considerablemente más bajo, especialmente entre los varones. Sin duda, esto no significa que la madre no juegue un papel importante en la práctica de la fe de los niños. No, su papel es fundamental. Simplemente enfatiza la importancia de la práctica religiosa del padre en el desarrollo espiritual y religioso de los hijos. (cf. “La Importancia de los Padres” por el Obispo Donald J. Reflexionando sobre San José en su *Carta Apostólica* de 2020 titulada “Con Corazón de Padre”, el Papa Francisco escribió: “Los padres no nacen, sino que se hacen. Un hombre no se convierte en padre simplemente por traer un hijo al mundo, sino por asumir la responsabilidad de cuidar de ese hijo. Cada vez que un hombre acepta la responsabilidad de la vida de otro, de alguna manera se convierte en un

padre para esa persona”. (Patris Corde, 7) Damos gracias a Dios por todos los padres y oramos para que vivan fiel e incansablemente la tarea que Dios les ha encomendado como líderes espirituales de sus familias. San José, ruega por nosotros. ¡Que tengan una bendecida semana!
