FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

You might recall that we are in the middle of the "Year of St. Joseph" which Pope Francis promulgated late last year. The Year of St. Joseph began December 8th, 2020 and will extend to December 8th of this year. In order to foster devotion to St. Joseph and to offer a way to grow spiritually, Bishop Jaime Soto has invited the faithful to participate in a pilgrimage to all the churches in the Diocese named after St. Joseph. You might know that the Diocese has a good number of parishes named "Sacred Heart". But we also have 11 parishes named after St. Joseph! Over the next six months, faithful are invited to visit each of the 11 churches and pray at each one. One can see where the St. Joseph churches are located and learn more about the pilgrimage here: <https://www.scd.org/stjoseph/journey>

It is also good to know that a plenary indulgence has been granted for those who are disposed and have completed the prayer or spiritual practice associated with the indulgence. One can find out more about the plenary indulgence here: <https://www.scd.org/stjoseph/indulgence> What is an indulgence? Good question! An indulgence is a remission of temporal punishment, or consequences, due to sin. Sin has consequences that are eternal and temporal. Jesus has suffered the eternal consequences for our sins by dying on the cross. He paid the price for our eternal consequences. Jesus took on the punishment of our sins, even though he was completely without guilt. Still, sins have consequences. With indulgences, the Church says that "we know that you have wandered and we want to give you something to help you find your way home, to help you heal". We can have our sins forgiven through the Sacrament of Confession, but even after being forgiven of our sins there is still some "spiritual rehabilitation" that needs to take place. Whatever rehab we don't do in this life, we are given the chance, and the gift, to complete our rehab and final purification in Purgatory. In His mercy, God created Purgatory so that we could be fully prepared to enjoy the joys of Heaven.

Another way of understanding indulgences is by way of analogy. Fr. Mike Schmitt explains that if I tear my shoulder muscle, I can try to repair the injury through physical rehabilitation. But if the pain persists, and the shoulder does not get better, I need to go to a doctor to have him surgically repair the shoulder. The physician completes the surgery, but I still need to do rehab in order to completely heal. The doctor tells me: "Do these exercises and you will be healed." An indulgence is like saying: "Do these exercises and they will strengthen your soul." Typically, to fulfill an indulgence, one must do the following: pray for the pope, go to confession, Receive the Eucharist, say a prayer or prayers and/or make a pilgrimage and pray, fast and give alms. Remember that an indulgence

is "extra-sacramental" which means that one benefits from the grace of the indulgence by already being a regularly practicing Catholic, in good standing and in the state of grace. By the way, on June 18th, Bob Dunning of "The Bishop's Hour" on Catholic radio (AM 1620) and I talked about the Catholic understanding of indulgences. Even though you may have missed the episode on the radio, one can listen to it on Apple Podcasts. You will also find on the same episode, a discussion about Catholic pilgrimages that Bob and Fr. George Snyder had.

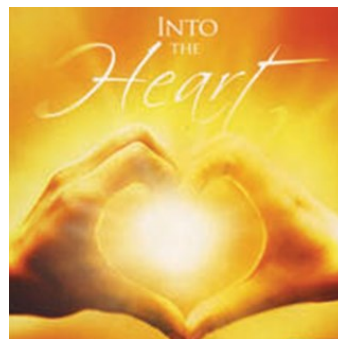

Estimados Feligreses de Santa Maria:

Tal vez recuerden que estamos a mediados del "Año de San José" el cual el Papa Francisco promulgó a finales del año pasado. El Año de San José comenzó el 8 de diciembre del 2020 y se extenderá hasta el 8 de diciembre de este año. Con el fin de fomentar la devoción a San José y ofrecer una manera de crecer espiritualmente, el Obispo Jaime Soto ha invitado a los fieles a participar en una peregrinación a todas las iglesias de la Diócesis que llevan el nombre de San José. Puede estar enterado que la Diócesis tiene un buen número de parroquias llamadas "Sagrado Corazón". ¡Pero también tenemos 11 parroquias que llevan el nombre de San José! Durante los próximos seis meses, se les invita a los fieles a visitar cada una de las 11 iglesias y orar en cada una de ellas. Podemos ver dónde se encuentran las iglesias de San José y aprender más sobre la peregrinación en este enlace: <https://www.scd.org/stjoseph/journey>

También es bueno saber que se ha concedido una indulgencia plenaria para aquellos que están dispuestos y han completado la oración o la práctica espiritual asociada con la indulgencia. Podemos encontrar más información sobre la indulgencia plenaria aquí: <https://www.scd.org/stjoseph/indulgence> ¿Qué es una indulgencia? ¡Buena pregunta! Una indulgencia es una remisión de castigo temporal, o consecuencias, debido al pecado. El pecado tiene consecuencias las cuales son eternas y temporales. Jesús ha sufrido las consecuencias eternas de nuestros pecados al morir en la cruz. Él pagó el precio por nuestras consecuencias eternas. Jesús asumió el castigo de nuestros pecados, a pesar de que estaba completamente libre de culpa. Aún así, los pecados tienen consecuencias. Con indulgencias, la Iglesia nos dice que "sabemos que te has desviado y queremos darte algo para ayudarte a encontrar el camino a casa, para ayudarte a sanar". Podemos hacer que nuestros pecados sean perdonados a través del Sacramento de la Confesión, pero incluso después de ser perdonados de nuestros pecados todavía hay algo de "rehabilitación espiritual" que necesita pasar. Cualquier rehabilitación que no hagamos en esta vida, se nos da la oportunidad, y el regalo, de completar nuestra rehabilitación y purificación final en el Purgatorio. En Su misericordia, Dios creó el Purgatorio para que pudiéramos estar completamente preparados para disfrutar de la dicha del Cielo.

Otra forma de entender las indulgencias es forma de analogía. El Padre Mike Schmitt explica que, si me desgarró el músculo del hombro, puedo tratar de reparar la lesión

a través de la rehabilitación física. Pero si el dolor persiste, y el hombro no mejora, necesito ir a un médico para que quirúrgicamente repare el hombro. El médico completa la cirugía, pero todavía tengo que hacer rehabilitación para sanar por completo. El médico me dice: "Haz estos ejercicios y te curarás". Una indulgencia es como decir: "Haz estos ejercicios y fortalecerán tu alma". Por lo general, para cumplir una indulgencia, uno debe de hacer lo siguiente: orar por el Papa, ir a la confesión, recibir la Eucaristía, decir una oración u oraciones y / o hacer una peregrinación y orar, ayunar y dar limosna. Recuerde que una indulgencia es "extra-sacramental", lo que significa que uno se beneficia de la gracia de la indulgencia al ser ya un católico practicante, en buen estado y estar en estado de gracia. Por cierto, el 18 de junio, Bob Dunning de "The Bishop's Hour" (La Hora del Obispo) en la radio católica (AM 1620) y yo hablamos sobre el entendimiento católico de las indulgencias. A pesar de que puede haberse perdido el episodio en la radio, uno puede escucharlo en Apple Podcasts. También encontrará en el mismo episodio, una discusión sobre las peregrinaciones católicas que Bob y el Padre George Snyder tuvieron.
