FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

As I mentioned at a couple of Masses last weekend, this weekend we get a "two-fer". Since the *Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary*, which is celebrated on August 15th, falls on a Sunday this year, faithful have the chance to fulfill their Sunday obligation as well as their "Assumption" obligation. As you know, all Catholics are obliged to attend Mass on every Sunday during the year. However, in addition to the Sunday obligation, there are also the "holy days of obligation" that come up during the year. Depending on the year, there can be as many as five holy days of obligation: Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Aug 15), Feast of All Saints (Nov 1), Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Dec 8), Christmas Day (Dec 25) and the Solemnity of the Mother of God (Jan 1).

Moreover, some years ago, the United States bishops, in an effort to make it easier for the faithful to fulfill their Sunday and holyday obligations, decided that for certain feast days which fall on a Saturday or Monday, the faithful would not be obligated to attend Mass on those occasions. Whether or not a holy day requires obligatory attendance depends on the feast day, on the year and on what day of the week the particular feast day falls. Thus, for example in 2022, Mary, the Mother of God, which falls on Saturday, Jan 1, 2022 *will not* be a holy day of obligation. Likewise, the Assumption of Mary on Aug 15, 2022 falls on a Monday, and *will not* be a holy day of obligation.

The Assumption is a wonderful feast because we not only honor the Blessed Virgin Mary for being assumed body and soul into heaven, but also we aspire someday to be united with God and all the angels and saints in heaven, spiritually and bodily. We are reminded from the Catechism (no. 966) that Mary's Assumption anticipates the "resurrection of all members of his Body." This means all members of the Body of Christ, that is, all of us, have the awesome gift of being resurrected bodily and spiritually. The gift of the resurrection of the body and soul that awaits us should move us to use our bodies and spirits well in this life to prepare for the life to come. It should be a good reminder that our bodies and souls ultimately do not belong to us. Our bodies and souls are gifts from God. They help us to be Our Lord's feet, heart, hands, ears, eyes and mouth so that we can bring others to Him.

The awareness that our bodies and souls ultimately belong to God should move us to think twice or thrice about choosing to do something sinful to them, either temporarily or permanently. On the one hand, I am referring to the intrinsic evil of contraception and sterilization. These are never acceptable according to Church teaching. On the other hand, I am also referring to having oneself marked

permanently with a tattoo. It is true that Church teaching does not condemn tattoos. Still, one should discern the reason for getting a tattoo. Is it to bring attention to oneself? Is it to remind oneself of a person or an important event in one's life? If it's the former, then it seems to me that is not a good reason to get a tattoo. If it's the latter, wouldn't it be easier to have a photograph or another reminder of said event or person for easy reference, rather than trying to find it on one's body? Granted, this is only my opinion. It is not Church teaching. Nonetheless, the overall governing principle for such a decision should be two-fold: our bodies and souls belong to God and they are to be given back to Him for His greater honor and glory.

On this Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary, may we all give thanks to God for our bodies and souls and ask Him to help us, through Saint Mary's intercession, to use our bodies and souls for His greater honor and glory to build up the Body of Christ. May you have a most blessed week!

• **Valid Photo ID:** Matricula, passport, school ID

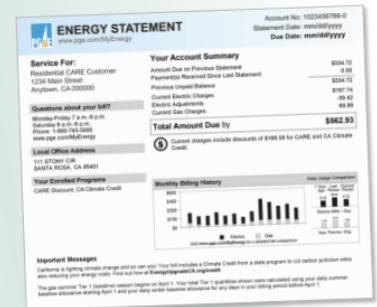


• **Proof of Address:** bills, official letters, or lease

Show loss of wages/severely reduced hours, housing or employment. *This could include letters or texts from your employer, evacuation orders, paystubs or tax returns for comparison.*



• **If you cannot provide these documents, you will need to verify your claim by providing your signature.**



LA ASUNCIÓN DE LA SANTÍSIMA VIRGEN MARÍA

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María:

Como mencioné en un par de Misas el fin de semana pasado, este fin de semana tenemos un "dos por uno". Dado que la Solemnidad de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María, que se celebra el 15 de agosto, cae en domingo este año, los fieles tienen la oportunidad de cumplir con su obligación dominical, así como con su obligación por el día de la "Asunción". Como saben, todos los católicos estamos obligados a asistir a Misa todos los domingos del año. Sin embargo, además de la obligación dominical, también están los "días de precepto" que surgen durante el año. Dependiendo en el año, puede haber hasta cinco días de precepto: La Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María (15 de agosto), Fiesta de Todos los Santos (1 de noviembre), Inmaculada Concepción de la Santísima Virgen María (8 de diciembre), Día de Navidad (25 de diciembre) y la Solemnidad de la Madre de Dios (1 de enero).

Además, hace algunos años, los obispos de los Estados Unidos, en un esfuerzo por facilitar a los fieles el cumplimiento de sus obligaciones dominicales y de días santos, decidieron que para ciertos días de festividad que caen en sábado o lunes, los fieles no estarían obligados a asistir a Misa en esas ocasiones. Si un día santo requiere o no la obligación de asistir a Misa, depende de la festividad, del año y en qué día de la semana cae la festividad en particular. Así, por ejemplo, en el 2022, la festividad de María, la Madre de Dios, cae el sábado 1^o de enero del 2022, no será un día santo de obligación. Asimismo, la Asunción de María el 15 de agosto de 2022 cae en lunes, no será un día santo de obligación.

La Asunción es una fiesta maravillosa porque no solo honramos a la Santísima Virgen María por haber sido asumida en cuerpo y alma en el cielo, sino que también aspiramos algún día a estar unidos con Dios y todos los ángeles y santos en el cielo, espiritual y corporalmente. Se nos recuerda desde el Catecismo (no. 966) que la Asunción de María anticipa "una anticipación de la resurrección de los demás cristianos". Esto significa que todos los miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo, es decir, todos nosotros, tenemos el impresionante don de resucitar corporal y espiritualmente. El don de la resurrección del cuerpo y el alma que nos espera debe movernos a usar bien nuestros cuerpos y espíritus en esta vida para prepararnos para la vida eterna. Debería ser un buen recordatorio de que nuestros cuerpos y almas ultimadamente no nos pertenecen. Nuestros cuerpos y almas son dones de Dios. Nos ayudan a ser los pies, el corazón, las manos, los oídos, los ojos y la boca de Nuestro

Señor para que podamos traer a los demás hacia Él.

La conciencia de que nuestros cuerpos y almas le pertenecen a Dios ultimadamente, debe movernos a pensar dos veces o tres veces acerca de elegir hacerle algo pecaminoso a nuestro cuerpo, ya sea temporal o permanentemente. Por un lado, me refiero al mal intrínseco de la anticoncepción y la esterilización. Estos nunca son aceptables de acuerdo con las enseñanzas de la Iglesia. Por otro lado, también me refiero marcarse permanentemente con un tatuaje. Es cierto que la enseñanza de la Iglesia no condena los tatuajes. Aun así, uno debe discernir la razón por la cual hacerse un tatuaje. ¿Es para llamar la atención hacia uno? ¿Es para recordar a una persona o un evento importante en la vida de uno? Si es por la primera razón, entonces me parece que no es una buena razón para hacerse un tatuaje. Si es por la segunda razón, ¿no sería más fácil tener una fotografía u otro recordatorio de dicho evento o persona como referencia, en lugar de tratar de encontrarlo en el cuerpo? Por supuesto, esta es sólo mi opinión. No es enseñanza de la Iglesia. No obstante, el gobernante moral de una decisión de este tipo debería ser doble: nuestros cuerpos y almas pertenecen a Dios y deben ser devueltos a Él para Su mayor honor y gloria.

En esta Solemnidad de la Asunción de María, todos demos gracias a Dios por nuestros cuerpos y almas y pidámosle que nos ayude, a través de la intercesión de Santa María, a usar nuestros cuerpos y almas para Su mayor honor y gloria para edificar el Cuerpo de Cristo. ¡Que tengan una semana muy bendecida!

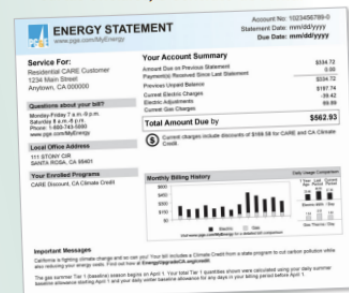

- **Comprobantes de adversidad** debido al fuego incontrolado, como pérdida de ingresos, horas significativamente rebajadas, perdida de hogar o empleo. *Esto puede incluir cartas o textos de su empleador, ordenes de evacuación, talón de cheques de pago, o declaración de ingresos para comparar.*



- En caso de que no tener estos comprobantes, deberá completar una declaración firmada.
