FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

As I begin my three month sabbatical, I wanted to give you a description of where I am living for the time being. I am living at St. Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park. The main reason I asked Fr. Mark Doherty, Rector of St. Patrick's, if I could live at the seminary for a time during my sabbatical is because Bishop Soto called me one day a couple of months ago and asked me to teach one day a week at St. Patrick's in the spring semester. I was not inclined to say no to the Bishop. So, it was arranged that I will be teaching a course on "theological anthropology".

Theological anthropology is the study of man's relationship to God and how that relationship is corrupted by sin and redeemed by Christ. I figured since I would need time to prepare the course ahead of time, I could benefit from the library at St. Patrick's and use some of the time of sabbatical to prepare the course.

The seminary grounds are very nice, situated on 40 acres in Menlo Park about 35 miles south of San Francisco. Without traffic, one can drive to Menlo Park in an hour and twenty minutes from Vacaville. Since the seminary was founded in 1898, more than 2,000 seminarians have studied at St. Pat's. Because I have been at St. Patrick's only since Sunday night, I am still getting to know the place and who lives and works there. (Since I was a seminarian at the North American College in Rome, I did not have the experience of being a seminarian at St. Patrick's.) By the end of this week, most of the 50 or so seminarians from 13 dioceses and one religious community will have returned from their summer assignments to begin classes on Monday.

As you can imagine, especially these days, to be accepted to the seminary, candidates for seminary go through a rather extensive application process including psychological testing and interviews. Upon acceptance, the bishop will recommend that a particular seminarian study at St. Patrick's. Presently, the Diocese of Sacramento sends seminarians to two main seminaries: St. Pat's and Mount Angel Seminary in Oregon. Once accepted in the seminary program, the seminarians will have at least four years of academic, spiritual and pastoral formation. The seminarians from the Diocese of Sacramento also spend a "pastoral year" in a parish. Presently, 5 of the 9 Sacramento seminarians live and study at St. Patrick's. As I get to know the faculty better, I can say that I am very impressed with the priests and laity who teach at the seminary. St. Patrick's is blessed with an excellent rector, in Fr. Mark Doherty, and a strong faculty.

The daily life of the seminarian includes daily Mass, praying the Liturgy of the Hours, including Lauds (or Morning Prayer) and Vespers (or Evening Prayer), Holy Hour, meals together, theology and philosophy classes (for

the "pre-theologians"), study, physical exercise, seminary chores and outside pastoral assignments. As you can imagine, life can be very full for a seminarian. Nonetheless, it is a good preparation for the priesthood which also can be full. Despite the demands, one learns to balance everything and to make sure that daily prayer, including Mass, praying the Liturgy of the Hours and Holy Hour, are always part and parcel of one's life.

Please know that I keep you all in my prayers during this time of being away and look forward to being back with you on a regular basis by Advent. Speaking of prayers, please remember to pray for our youth (and a few adults) who will be confirmed by Bishop Soto this coming Saturday, August 28th. I can attest that our confirmation students have been well-prepared over the past couple years, culminating with the excellent retreat they participated in last weekend. Please pray for them, and pray for their parents, that they continue to grow in grace and holiness. May you have a most blessed week!

VIGÉSIMO PRIMER DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

22 de agosto de 2021

Después de hablar de dar su carne a comer, muchos de los discípulos de Jesús se alejaron. (Juan 6:60-69).



DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa Maria:

Al comenzar mis tres meses sabáticos, quiero darles una descripción de dónde estoy viviendo por el momento. Estoy viviendo en el Seminario San Patricio (St. Patrick's Seminary) en Menlo Park. La razón principal por la que le pregunté al Padre Mark Doherty, Rector de San Patricio, si podía vivir en el seminario por un tiempo durante mi tiempo sabático, es porque el Obispo Soto me llamó un día hace un par de meses y me pidió que diera clases un día a la semana en San Patricio durante el semestre de primavera. No estaba inclinado a decirle que no al Obispo. Por lo tanto, se hicieron los arreglos para que yo diera un curso sobre "antropología teológica". La antropología teológica es el estudio de la relación del hombre con Dios y cómo esa relación es corrompida por el pecado y redimida por Cristo. Pensé que, ya que necesitaría tiempo para preparar el curso con anticipación, podría beneficiarme de la biblioteca en San Patricio y usar parte del tiempo sabático para preparar el curso.

Los terrenos del seminario son muy bonitos, situado en 40 acres en Menlo Park a unas 35 millas al sur de San Francisco. Sin tráfico, uno puede llegar a Menlo Park en una hora y veinte minutos de Vacaville. Desde que el seminario fue fundado en 1898, más de 2,000 seminaristas han estudiado en San Patricio. Debido a que he estado en San Patricio solo desde el domingo por la noche, todavía me estoy familiarizando con el lugar y quién vive y trabaja allí. (Ya que yo fui un seminarista en el Colegio Norteamericano en Roma, no tuve la experiencia de ser un seminarista en San Patricio.) Para finales de esta semana, la mayoría de los 50 seminaristas de 13 diócesis y una comunidad religiosa habrán regresado de sus asignaciones de verano para comenzar las clases el lunes.

Como pueden imaginar, especialmente en estos días, para ser aceptados en el seminario, los candidatos al seminario pasan por un proceso de solicitud bastante extenso que incluye pruebas psicológicas y entrevistas. Tras la aceptación, el obispo recomendará que un seminarista en particular estudie en San Patricio. Actualmente, la Diócesis de Sacramento envía seminaristas a dos seminarios principales: San Patricio y Seminario Monte Ángel (Mount Angel) en Oregon. Una vez aceptados en el programa de seminario, los seminaristas tendrán al menos cuatro años de formación académica, espiritual y pastoral. Los seminaris-

tas de Sacramento viven y estudian en San Patricio. A medida que conozco mejor la facultad, puedo decir que estoy muy impresionado con los sacerdotes y laicos que enseñan en el seminario. San Patricio está bendecido con un excelente rector, con el Padre Mark Doherty, y una facultad sólida.

La vida diaria del seminarista incluye la Misa diaria, la oración de la Liturgia de las Horas, incluyendo Laudes (u Oración Matutina) y Vísperas (u Oración Vespertina), la Hora Santa, las comidas juntos, las clases de teología y filosofía (para los "pre-teólogos"), el estudio, el ejercicio físico, las tareas del seminario y las asignaciones pastorales externas. Como se pueden imaginar, la vida puede ser muy plena para un seminarista. No obstante, es una buena preparación para el sacerdocio que también puede ser pleno. A pesar de las demandas, uno aprende a equilibrar todo y a asegurarse de que la oración diaria, incluyendo la Misa, la oración de la Liturgia de las Horas y la Hora Santa, sean siempre parte integral de la vida.

Por favor, sepan que los mantengo a todos en mis oraciones durante este tiempo que estaré fuera y espero estar de vuelta con ustedes regularmente para el Adviento. Hablando de oraciones, por favor recuerde orar por nuestros jóvenes (y algunos adultos) que serán confirmados por el Obispo Soto el próximo sábado 28 de agosto. Puedo dar fe de que nuestros estudiantes de confirmación han sido preparados muy bien en los últimos dos años, culminando con el excelente retiro en el cual participaron el fin de semana pasado. Por favor oren por ellos, y oren por sus padres, para que continúen creciendo en gracia y santidad. ¡Que tengan una semana muy bendecida!
