FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

(The following account is shared with permission)

A few days ago, I was called to the home of a parishioner to give them the Anointing of the Sick and Holy Communion. These are part of the prayers we colloquially call the "Last Rites". It prepares the soul to stand before the Judgment Seat of God. When I walked out of that house, I thought to myself, "I think I just anointed a saint." Wow...

After ringing the doorbell, her husband came to the door. "Thank you for coming", he said to me as he reached out to shake my hand. "She will be happy to see you." We both put on our medical masks due to her delicate immune system. He led me down the hallway to the master bedroom, as I glanced at the framed family photos to my left and my right. Wide smiles of young faces covered each picture. This is a family that loves to smile. As the entry way into the bedroom loomed closer, a little apprehension came over. I've done this routine hundreds of times over the years as a priest but it never gets easier. I never know what to expect when I walk through the door of someone terminally ill. Sadness? Anger? Tears? All of the above perhaps?

As I walked into her room, the white curtains were drawn closed over the large window directly behind the head of the bed. It casted a diffused, warm light over the whole space. A wooden statue of the Blessed Mother stood on a nightstand beside her. She greets me with the utmost reverence and gratitude. "Father!" she says struggling, as her teeth chatter against one another uncontrollably. Her medication gives her fevers and numbing chills. Her husband grabs a gray blanket and gently places it over the other layers for warmth. The battle with cancer has taken its toll understandably, but the chemo seems to have devastated her body worse than the disease.

We talked briefly about the trip to Lourdes she and her husband took last year, as they begged the Blessed Mother to help them pray for a miracle. It wasn't so. She looks up towards Heaven and says, "My only hope is that I'm ready Father. I don't want to be separated..." At first, I thought she meant her two children. "I don't want to be separated from Our Lord. I can't even stand the thought of Purgatory. I just want to finally see him." Her teeth chatter some more. She smiles with what meager energy she has left, "You're always in my prayers Father."

I can't help but marvel at people like this. As the world goes about its hectic pace, hidden souls are quietly living their own Calvary, right here in Vacaville.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

(Este relato se comparte con permiso)

Hace unos días me llamaron a la casa de una feligrés para darle la Unción de Enfermos y la Sagrada Comunión. Estas son parte de las oraciones que coloquialmente llamamos los “Santos Óleos”. Prepara al alma para comparecer ante el Juicio de Dios. Cuando salí de esa casa, pensé: “Creo que acabo de ungir a un santo”. Guau...

Después de tocar el timbre, su esposo salió a la puerta. “Gracias por venir”, me dijo mientras se acercaba para estrecharme la mano. “Le dará gusto verlo”. Ambos nos pusimos nuestras máscaras médicas debido a su delicado sistema inmunológico. Me condujo por el pasillo hasta el dormitorio principal, mientras miraba las fotos familiares enmarcadas a mi izquierda y mi derecha. Amplias sonrisas de rostros jóvenes cubrieron cada imagen. Esta es una familia a la que le encanta sonreír. A medida que me acercaba a la entrada al dormitorio, se apoderó de mí un poco de aprensión. He hecho esta rutina cientos de veces a lo largo de los años como sacerdote, pero no se hace más fácil. Nunca sé qué esperar cuando cruzo la puerta de alguien con una enfermedad terminal. ¿Tristeza? ¿Coraje? ¿Lágrimas? ¿Quizás todo lo anterior?

Cuando entré en su habitación, las cortinas blancas estaban cerradas sobre la gran ventana directamente detrás de la cabecera de la cama. Proyectaba una luz cálida, que se dispersaba sobre todo el espacio. Una estatua de madera de la Santísima Madre estaba en una mesita de noche junto a ella. Ella me saluda con la mayor reverencia y gratitud. “¡Padre!” dice con dificultad, mientras su quijada temblaba de frío incontrolablemente. Su medicamento le provoca fiebre y escalofríos que la adormecen. Su esposo agarra una cobija gris y la coloca suavemente sobre las otras capas para darle calor. Se entiende que la batalla contra el cáncer sea dura, pero la quimioterapia parece haber devastado su cuerpo peor que la enfermedad.

Hablamos brevemente sobre el viaje a Lourdes que ella y su esposo hicieron el año pasado, mientras le rogaban a la Santísima Madre que los ayudara a orar por un milagro. No fue así. Ella mira hacia el cielo y dice: “Mi única esperanza es estar lista, Padre. No quiero que me separen...” Al principio pensé que se refería a sus dos hijos. “No quiero separarme de Nuestro Señor. Ni siquiera puedo soportar la idea del Purgatorio. Solo quiero por fin verlo”. Sus quijadas temblaban un poco más. Ella sonríe con la poca energía que le quedaba, “Siempre está en mis oraciones Padre”.

No puedo evitar maravillarme de personas así. A medida que el mundo sigue su ritmo frenético, las almas ocultas están viviendo tranquilamente su propio Calvario, aquí mismo en Vacaville.
